This project involved the refurbishment of seven public conveniences in Edinburgh’s City Centre.

Each needed existing facilities stripped out and refitted, as well as repairing walls, floors and tiles.

New paddle gates were also fitted for the first time, to allow charging.

This was Hubco’s first Hub Lite project – a model for smaller projects which streamlines the processes involved to ensure a quicker turnaround from commission to construction.

Hubco worked with the Council to engineer an accelerated programme which seen two of the locations being ready in time for the busy Festival period in August, with the remainder following soon after.
