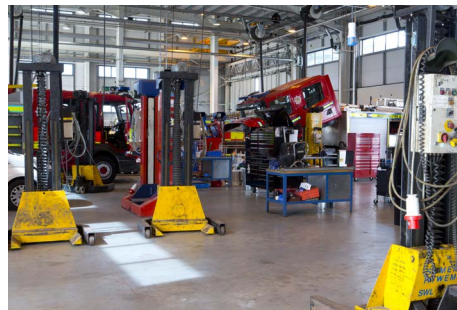
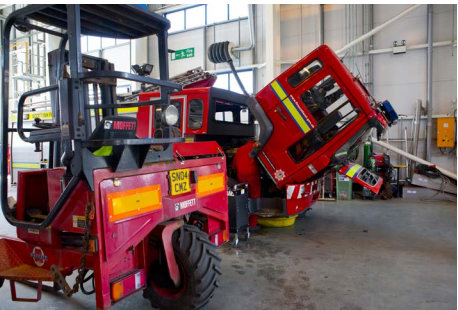


Newbridge Fire & Rescue Service Workshop Alterations

The Scottish Fire and Rescue Service's facility at Newbridge is used primarily as a vehicle maintenance depot, consisting of a workshop/office unit and external storage areas.



The project consisted of refurbishment/alteration of the accommodation layout within the existing building to rationalise workshop/training and auxiliary welfare areas.



As well as this there was the formation of additional office spaces within the large fleet workshop and property workshop areas, and the provision of additional lockers, shower and toilet facilities.

In addition, the installation of a 40,000 litre fuel tank and provision of a new oil storage facility were required, along with a new internal mezzanine level and new perimeter fencing, gates and signage.
