Jedburgh Grammar Campus *Scottish Borders Council*




The Jedburgh Intergenerational Community Campus in the Scottish Borders is an educational facility under construction which will serve 2 to 18 year olds, as well as providing further education opportunities and community facilities for the town.

Being delivered through a partnership between Hub South East and Scottish Borders Council, with BAM Construction as the main contractor, this new inspiring learning space was handed over on time and within budget in early 2020.

The new campus replaces all three schools in the town and will have provision for nursery, primary and secondary school children. Community facilities will include a multi-use games area, 2G hockey pitch, 3G sports pitch, running track, external changing pavilion and rural skills area.

The fact that discussions began from a standing start only 18 months before Financial Close (by which point construction had already progressed to steel structure stage) is demonstrable evidence of what can be achieved when the true partnership working ethos of the Hub initiative is embraced.

We met or exceeded our targets for delivering community benefits on the Jedburgh Grammar Campus, supporting hundreds of days work placement, a number of new jobs and 18 new and existing trainees / apprenticeships.

The Hub programme aims to maximise opportunities for local employment and promotes the use of Scottish SMEs where possible.

Using a local supply chain is a key driver and an example of this in action on the Jedburgh Campus project is Jedburgh based RJT Excavations.

This local company was awarded the groundworks contract and was on site early in the programme preparing the site for the main build.
